- My purpose today is not like “Go to market” scenario but just show how charming and interesting to go those areas and encourage you to go there in person!

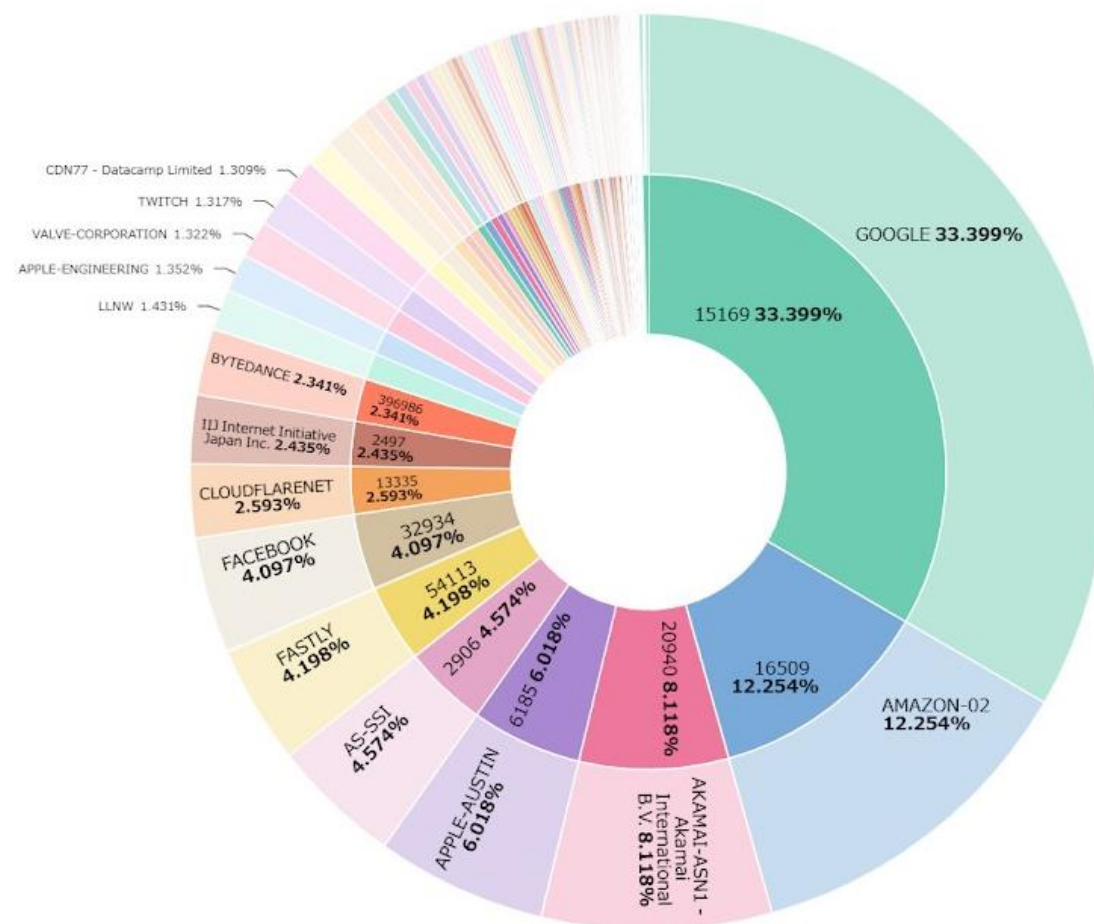

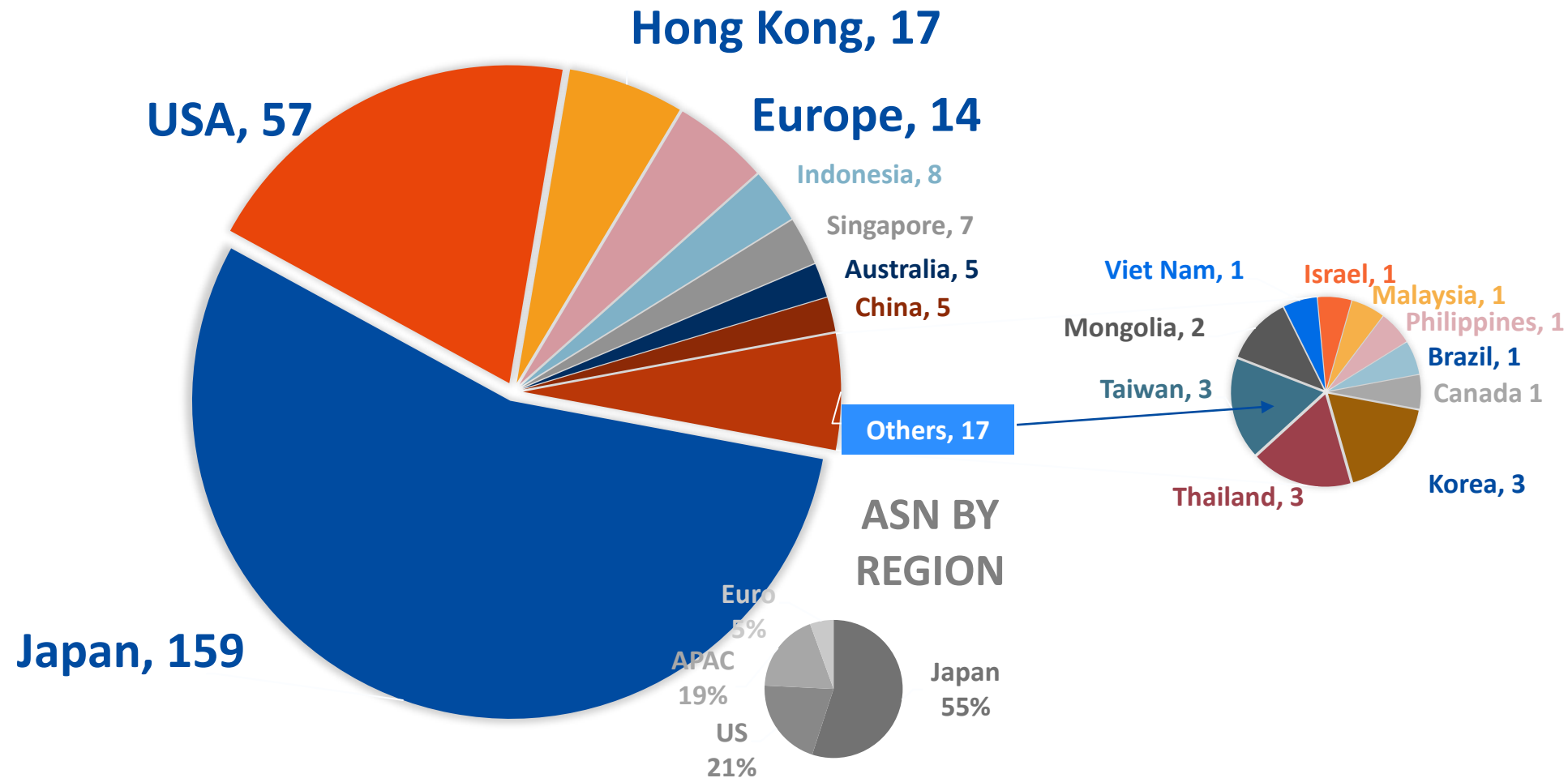


# Back Data 1 : JPIX Traffic Analysis
